**BRANCH RULES**:Riding members must complete 5 working rallies marked present for the<br/>whole rally, of 1 ½ hours coaching time. Which can be a minimum of 3<br/>ridden and 2 unmounted, and they must qualify the mount/mounts you<br/>will compete on for AMPC and Area competitions. Riders may qualify more<br/>than one mount with the required number of rallies for each horse. (New<br/>rules may apply for area competitions)<br/>If something happens to the horse or rider, injury etc You must apply for<br/>a DISPENSATION. This must be in writing, setting out the reasons for you<br/>to ride a different horse. This must be through your Head Coach and the<br/>Branch Committee who then present it at the next District meeting

COACHING:All branches have a Head Coach and/or Rally Co-ordinator. They are<br/>appointed by your Branch Committee to organise rallies,<br/>Certificate work, exams and must arrange the Coaching for all riding<br/>members in your Branch.<br/>At Club level, we have a Head Coach – This is an administrative position<br/>to support Coaching for riders, co-ordinate Club Teams and events and<br/>assist and support the Branch Coaches, Committees, Parents & Riders.

## PONY CLUB CERTIFICATE EXAM AND ASSESSMENT DAYS:

These are held on two dates during each PC season: (Dates to be confirmed) For riders from D+ to C+ Certificates. B Exams are organized by Auckland Area and A&H Exams by NZPCA, January and June 2025. D Certificate is completed at rally by the Head Coach or an examiner appointed by them.

Coaching staff will put forward names of riders who have reached the standard to sit each level, examiners and assessors appointed by Manukau District PC conduct the exams. After the exam, there is a summing up with the examiners or assessors, to which parents are invited to hear the feedback and confirmation of pass or fail.

At C+ level, there is an assessment first, then the exam is held 6 weeks later, the same applies at B, H & A levels. At all these levels, candidates may sit either HM or Riding section of the exam or the whole exam in one day.

At D+ and C, there is only one exam and riders must sit both sections of HM and riding to pass.

The requirements for each level are contained in PC Manuals 1 and 2 and off the Record Card held at your Pony Club for each rider. They are also available on the NZPCA website.
